Dr Prax is sending supplier contact information about Rebuilder (nerve regenerator) and Anodyne (infrared system to improve blood circulation).

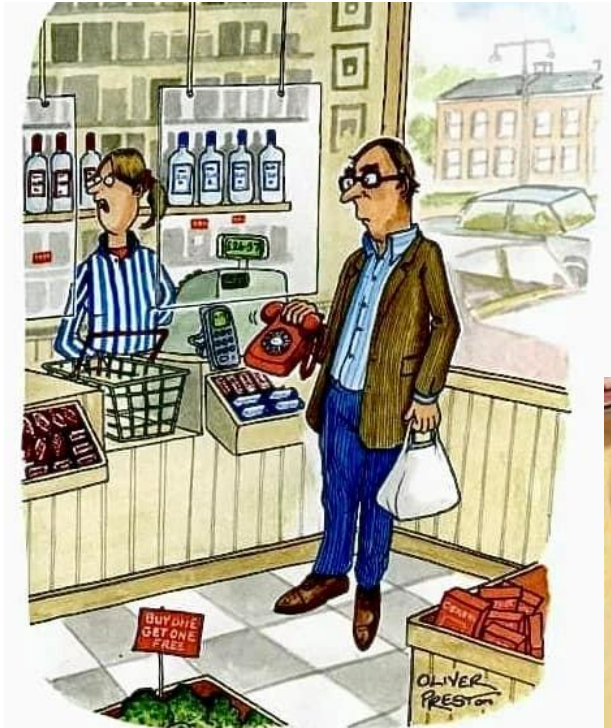
Dr Prax utilises and incorporates products as part of his *overall* treatment plan for his patients.

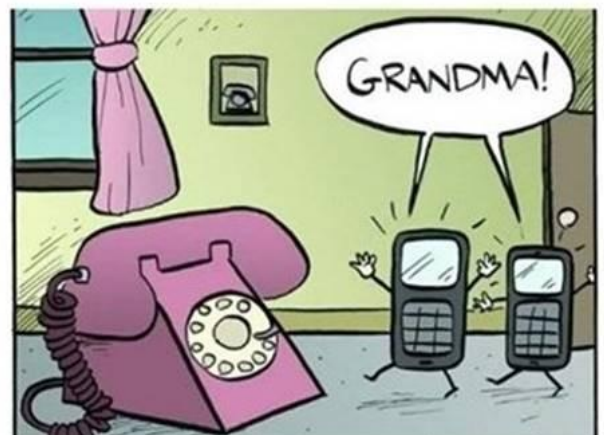
