SUMMARY

This CV outlines the extensive professional and community-focused career of **Peter H**, an Australian professional with significant experience in education, project management, and humanitarian leadership across Australia and Malaysia (p. 1).

Professional Experience

- **Current Leadership:** Since early 2025, Peter has served as the Director of Community Projects for the **Here for Good Foundation** (focused on domestic violence) and the Founder of the **Peripheral Neuropathy Support Group SA** (p. 1).
- **Employment Advocacy:** Since 2019, he has coordinated the **Jobs Café** in Stepney, providing voluntary job-seeking assistance to refugees, migrants, and vulnerable groups. As of March 2026, the initiative has secured approximately 540 jobs (p. 1).
- **International Project Management:** He held several senior roles in **Malaysia** (1997–2018), including:
 - **General Manager** at Palm Biogreen, managing factory production and logistics (pp. 1-2).
 - **Project Manager** for major oil tank cleaning projects at the Petronas Melaka Refinery, successfully returning approx. USD \$3 million (p. 2).
 - **Management & Training** roles for legal firms and business resource companies (p. 2).
- **Education & Development:** Earlier in his career, he was the Director of Development at **Pembroke School** and **Annesley College** in Adelaide (p. 2). He also spent over a decade as a Mathematics and Science teacher (p. 2).

- **Tertiary:** Studied Mathematics and Chemistry at the **University of Adelaide** and attended the **Royal Military College, Duntroon** (p. 1).
- **Professional:** Holds a Diploma in Teaching from Adelaide Teachers College (1970) (p. 1).
